



WPOA Lightning Procedure

- In addition to listening for thunder and watching for lightning in the area, WPOA Pool Staff utilize SKYSCAN & TALOS devices to help determine if lightning is present nearby.
- If the staff or equipment determine lightning is present nearby, the pools will be closed until the threat passes.
- Pools will remain closed for a minimum of 30 minutes after the first indication of a threat.
- Re-opening the pool will occur if there is no SKYSCAN device warning and no visible sign of lightning or sound of thunder for a 30 minute period.
- Owners and guests must exit the pool upon closure and not enter the pool until staff re-open the facility.

Enforcement of Rules: Owners or guests who fail to follow the rules will be reminded of the rules. Owners or guests who repeatedly fail to follow the rules will be asked to leave the facility; owners risk losing pool privileges for their household for the remainder of the swimming season.
