



Chestnut Springs and Rodes Farm Pool Rules

- **WPOA pools operate daily from 10 am until 8 pm during the summer season (Pools are staffed until 6 pm, pools close at 6 pm on Thursdays for chemical maintenance)**
- **Facility and grounds close at 8PM. Parking lot must be cleared by 8:30 PM at both the Chestnut Springs Pool and the Rodes Farm Pool.**
- **Owners with their accompanied guests may use the pool from 10am until closing**
- **Unaccompanied guests may use the pool from 2pm until 6pm closing**
- **SIX guests per property may access the pool. Example: one owner and five guests can use the pool, two owners and four guests, or six guests. The limit on people using WPOA pools per property is six (regardless of whether an owner or guest)**
- **Children under the age of 15 years old must have adult supervision. All pool participants must sign in, acknowledging both risks and pool rules**
- **Owners and guests are prohibited from using the facility if they are sick, have tested positive for COVID-19, or recently exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19**
- **Swim Diapers required for young children/toddlers**
- **No glass containers in the pool area**
- **No pets in the pool area. Service dogs may be permitted.** Under ADA and VA law, facilities are not required to allow emotional support animals, only documented service animals. No animals are allowed in the pool
- **Pool will be closed temporarily during thunder and lightning. Owners and guests must exit pool and may not enter the pool until staff re-open the facility**
- **Owners and guests are required to follow the directions of the pool staff**
- **No use of foul language or abusive behavior toward other owners, guests or pool staff**
- **Lifeguards are not always present. Swim at your own risk**
- **Enforcement of Rules: Owners or guests who fail to follow the rules will be reminded of the rules. Owners or guests who repeatedly fail to follow the rules will be asked to leave the facility; owners risk losing all pool privileges for their household for the remainder of the swimming season.**
